I can still remember my first day going down to Marconi's, we stayed initially at Springfield Place, which was a Marconi Hostel for about 40 of us lads. And I amongst seven other people were specially selected because we were short, I didn't realise I was short until that time, but it meant that we could go right into the top of the hostel in what we call the ship room which had very low beams. So there were eight of us in this room up top of Springfield Place. We always laughed that it was like being on a ship or something. And we had a whale of time, you can imagine the lights never went off in the ship room. I can remember many wheels being rolled on the centre of the room, there was always music on and we had a whale of a time. There were other rooms with people in but not quite as big or as exciting as the ship room at the top of Springfield Place. Yeah, so I think that was the main thing I remember about the early days there.
